## Live Out Loud Children's Education **Spending Agreement**

The following template is to establish the rules and guidelines for how much your child is able to withdraw or spend from the funds they create by completing their tasks.

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Have a conversation about the types of things your child may want with the money they create. This can be anything that is not a direct need such as a television, or could be for a long-term future expense such as a car.
- After you've agreed upon the goals, work together to create rules around how much your child is able to withdraw or spend from their account on a weekly basis.
- What other money rules will be in place? Will money be reserved for charity? For older children, will there be a "tax" for things such as a college fund or other expenses?
